Bradfield Home/School Transport Update

Dear Parent;

You will receive a newsletter today in which you will see that at the time of printing we had no further news re the school bus situation for September 2017.

I have recently had fairly extensive discussions with The South Yorkshire Passenger Transport Executive (SYPTTE) and as a result of those discussions I am confident that there will be a service in place for September. At this moment in time the costings, which for Bradfield are extensive, are still to be approved by SYPTTE Executive Board and one of the bus routes is out for tender so I cannot supply any other information. However, I would like to give two assurances:

- There will be school transport available in September and the school is very happy with the assurances they have been given by the SYPTTE that they will work with the school to ensure the service is adequate;
- Once we know finalised details we will use the various school media to circulate information to parents to ensure you are well aware of the arrangements prior to your child's return to school in September 2017.

In conclusion, I would like to say that the plans that are being put in place are likely to lead to improvements to many aspects of our existing service.
